## **JANUARY CREATIVITY CHALLENGE**

Painting Shadows First
From the Nita Leland Workbook on Exploring Color

"Some artists start by painting shadows first, building forms based on light and dark pattern of an established direction of light. Then they glaze color over the shadow portions. Other artists complete the painting and add the shadows last so they will be less likely to confuse the direction of the light while painting. Still others develope the shadows as they go along, keeping a fixed source of light in mind throughout. The shadow pattern in the shadows only sketch unify the different areas in the picture when you add color the Shadows fall into place without calling undo attention to themselves." ~ Nita Leland.

## Your challenge is to paint the Shadows First.

Sketch your subject and create (paint) all the shadows with a low intensity blue or violet or chromatic gray tint. Pay careful attention to the patterns of the shadow shapes, connecting them to achieve a cohesive pattern. When the Shadows are done, glaze over them with the colors of the objects, influenced by the dominant light to unify the picture. You can add additional color and value contrast anywhere it's needed, when the glazes are dry.

## The beginning of Pocket Sketching for me

I came across Pocket Sketching in 2017 when Kath Macaulay taught a workshop at the Hill Country Arts Foundation in Ingram, Texas. Kath developed Pocket Sketching in the late 1980's and has taught the technique across the US and now has a series on PBS.

It was a pivotal moment for me – I fell in love with sketching on the go and haven't looked back since! I became a certified Pocket Sketcher instructor in 2022 to enhance my skills in sharing this exciting technique with others.



#### A little background

My art journey began as a teenager as I explored various mediums – especially pastels - and received my first commission at age 16. Early formal training includes an Associate of Arts degree as an art major. Over the years I have been privileged to study with several prominent pastel masters including Albert Handell, Clive Tyler, Teresa Saia, and Tobi Clement. My work now encompasses the mediums of pastel, watercolor, and gouache. My paintings are known for an expressive use of radiant and rich color reflecting my love of the Southwest and its vast views.
