Born and educated in Canada, Carla Gauthier has also lived and worked in the U.S. and Europe, and now resides in Houston, Texas where she continues to paint and teach. While earning her BA in Fine Art and Art History and her Bachelor of Education, she continued to

paint in watercolors and oil paints. An education in traditional drawing and printmaking provided her with a solid base in image making.

Carla is a signature member of the prestigious National Watercolor Society Transparent Watercolor Society of America, Louisiana Watercolor Society, Watercolor West, Canadian Society of Painters in Watercolor, Watercolor Art Society, Houston – Elite Signature

She has shown with these and other organizations in regional, national and international exhibitions, and has work in art collections in Canada, U.S. and Europe. More recently she has been a judge for

regional art shows and watercolor exhibitions and leading 3-5 day watercolor workshops on topics like Limited Palette, Architectural Details and Creating Atmosphere.





Carla's work combines her love of architectural detail and attention to qualities of light that transform commonplace scenes. The result is a body of work that reads like snapshots....found scenes that capture the light and people going about their daily life their story unfolding before us.

A trained teacher, she is always searching and experimenting, ready to share with other watercolor artists. Working mainly in the studio, she is inspired by a sense of light and glow in her landscape and interior subjects. Good shapes defined by strong values are the cornerstone of her subject choices – color is always secondary. Building up colors and textures while balancing values, she works towards a sharp focal point, full of contrast and detail.

Kandi moved to Kerrville 2 ½ years ago from Colorado. She appreciates the thriving art community in Kerrville. She teaches classes in watercolor here at the KACC. She enjoys painting in a variety of genres but is most inspired by a connection to the subject, a scene that tells a story, light effects & shadows, or beauty.



Kandi shared information about her supplies and the process that she uses for protective measures when framing watercolors without glass. Her reasons for using this process are to make her art more affordable; give a more modern or contemporary look and to remove the distraction of glass reflection. It also makes it easier for gift-giving, not putting the expense of framing on herself or the recipient. It's safer and easier to ship. And it has been well received when used for her pet portrait commissions.

Supplies: Liquitex Satin Varnish (liquid safe for watercolor used outside in well-ventilated area), Golden Gesso (acrylic primer), Golden Extra Heavy Gel Gloss, Dorland's Wax Medium, Varathane Less Mess Wood Stain, Deo Art Gloss Enamels, Krylon Kamar Varnish, Da Vinci Pro Panels (Birch), Ampersand Hardboard, New Zealand Pine Cradles (7/8" and thicker), Sheffield Cutter (must be sharp), Exacto Knife, Self Healing Craft Mat, Sandpaper in assorted grits (150 & 220 used the most), Disposable Gloves, Foam Brushes, Nylon Brush,, Brayer, Spatula, Lint free Cotton Cloth (old tshirts), Paper Towels, Box Lid for spraying Varnish(from computer monitor), a stack of Heavy Books (for pressing paintings flat overnight), and Watercolor Paper (140 lb Arches, 200 lb Fabriano Artistico or Saunders Waterford).

Locally she uses Hometown Crafts. After the expense for the investment made in the initial purchase of the supplies there is less of a future expense for framing, shipping, and gifting of paintings.
