Nancy Huffman

Nature Journaling and Building Skills in Your Sketchbook



Nancy Huffman is a lifelong artist and art teacher. Nature journaling has slowly found its way into her work over time. Although she has always sketched from life, when Covid hit she took on nature journaling in her back yard to learn about plant families and has continued since.

Nature journaling is all about observation skills utilizing drawing, not about making art. It is about learning about

your subject matter before you start painting so that you understand it thoroughly. While it is preferable to work from life, we will also discuss how to go about making studies of inaccessible subjects so that you understand it in three-dimensions. Nancy has studied plant life and birds using these methods.









Come prepared to draw and watercolor. We will work together from life after a brief introduction while discussing important points. Nancy will have paper and basic supplies, but feel free to bring your own favorites.

In addition to creating her own art, Nancy facilitates a journaling group for the Native Plant Society of Texas Kerrville in which she guides, sharing hacks to make it accessible to non-artists and artists alike. Her personal work is primarily in oil, but she also enjoys water-

color and gouache. She is represented by Adams Galleries of Austin.

Al Kline Workshop Info

This is a Basics to Advanced watercolor course. This course is designed to discuss and demonstrate basic watercolor concepts through examples. As we become comfortable with the fundamentals during the course work, we will introduce more advanced techniques aimed at enhancing your paintings. We will discuss the significance of value/tone in painting and transition from simple value painting with a single color to using a full color palette. We will cover my color theory and how to move from value studies to color paintings. Additionally, we will address composition, design, drawing, watercolor washes, value painting, and the three stages of watercolor painting.
